

DO NOT MIX DIFFERENT FORMS OF CHLORINATING PRODUCTS





There are four types of chlorinating products.

They may look similar but they are incompatible with each other. If you are uncertain of what type of chlorine you are using read the label.

Mixing different chlorinating compounds can result in a volatile reaction capable of causing bodily harm.

Liquid Chlorine AKA "Bleach"

Available as a liquid



Sodium dichloro-s-triazinetrione AKA "Dichlor"

Available as a granular



Calcium Hypochlorite AKA "Cal Hypo" Also known as "NST" tablets or non stabilized tablets

Trichloro-s-triazinetrione AKA "Trichlor"

DO NOT USE THE WRONG CHLORINE TABLETS IN YOUR CHLORINATOR



Placing the wrong type of chlorinating tablets or mixing different forms of chlorine tablets in a tablet feeder will cause a reaction that produces considerable heat and toxic gasses. This rapid formation of gas inside a tablet feeder can cause enough pressure to blow the lid off the feeder or can be violent enough to cause the feeder to explode!

DO NOT POUR CHLORINATING COMPOUNDS INTO THE SKIMMER



Follow instructions on label for appropriate application.

If uncertain broadcast over the top of the pool, and use wall brush to distribute any of the material that has settled on the pool bottom
